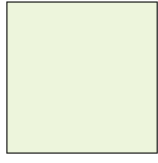
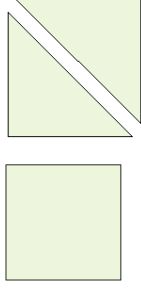


Assemble the Quilt Blocks

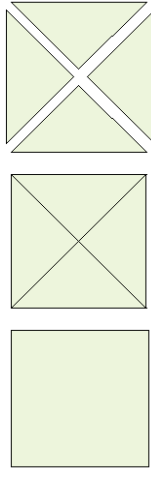


1) Cut 14" setting squares to separate the pieced blocks.
Quantity needed: (Throw = 2, Twin = 6, Full = 9,
Queen = 12, King = 16)

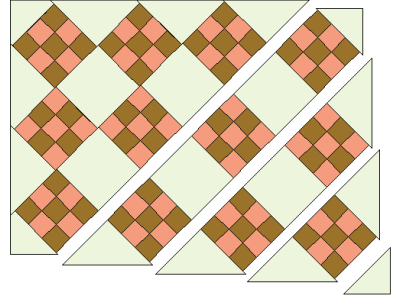
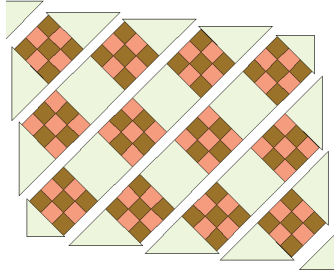


2) Cut Two 14 1/2" Squares. Cut each square in half diagonally to produce the four setting corners of the quilt top.

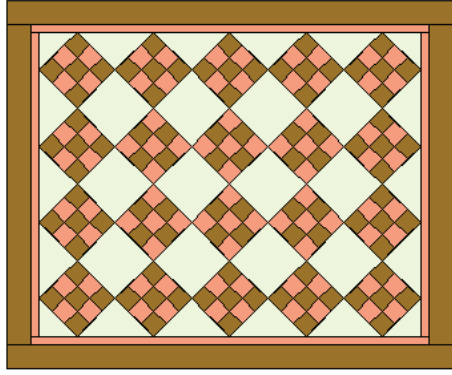
3) Cut 21" Squares. Quantity needed: (Throw = 2, Twin = 3, Full = 3,
Queen = 4, King = 4). Draw two diagonal lines on each and cut on the line to separate each square into four setting triangles.



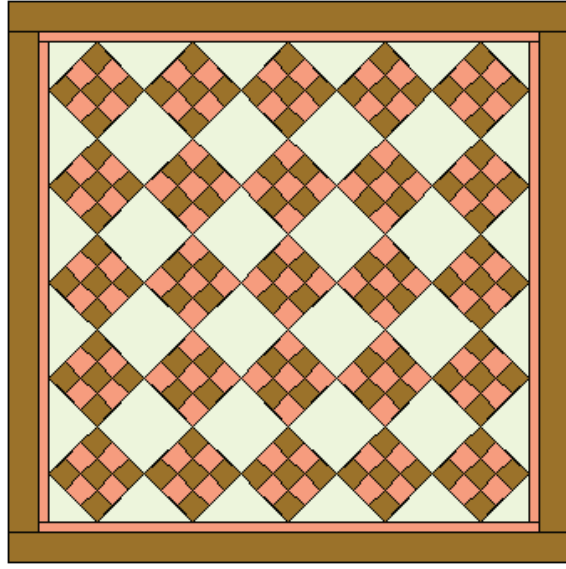
4) Refer to the bed sizes layouts (Pages 4-5) for the placement of the various blocks. Note: Pay particular attention to the placement of the two different colored pieced blocks. Using a 1/4" seam allowance, connect the various pieced blocks, plain setting squares, triangles and corner triangles together in diagonal rows.



5) Now join the rows together using a 1/4" seam allowance. When the rows are sewn together they form the rectangular shape of the quilt top.



Queen: 20 Blocks
4 Across x 5 Down
92" x 111 1/2"



King: 25 Blocks
5 Across x 5 Down
111 1/2" x 111 1/2"
